Please see additional rules and regulations for this beat. It is a Ribble byelaw that no more than 2 salmon can be kept in any one season by one angler.

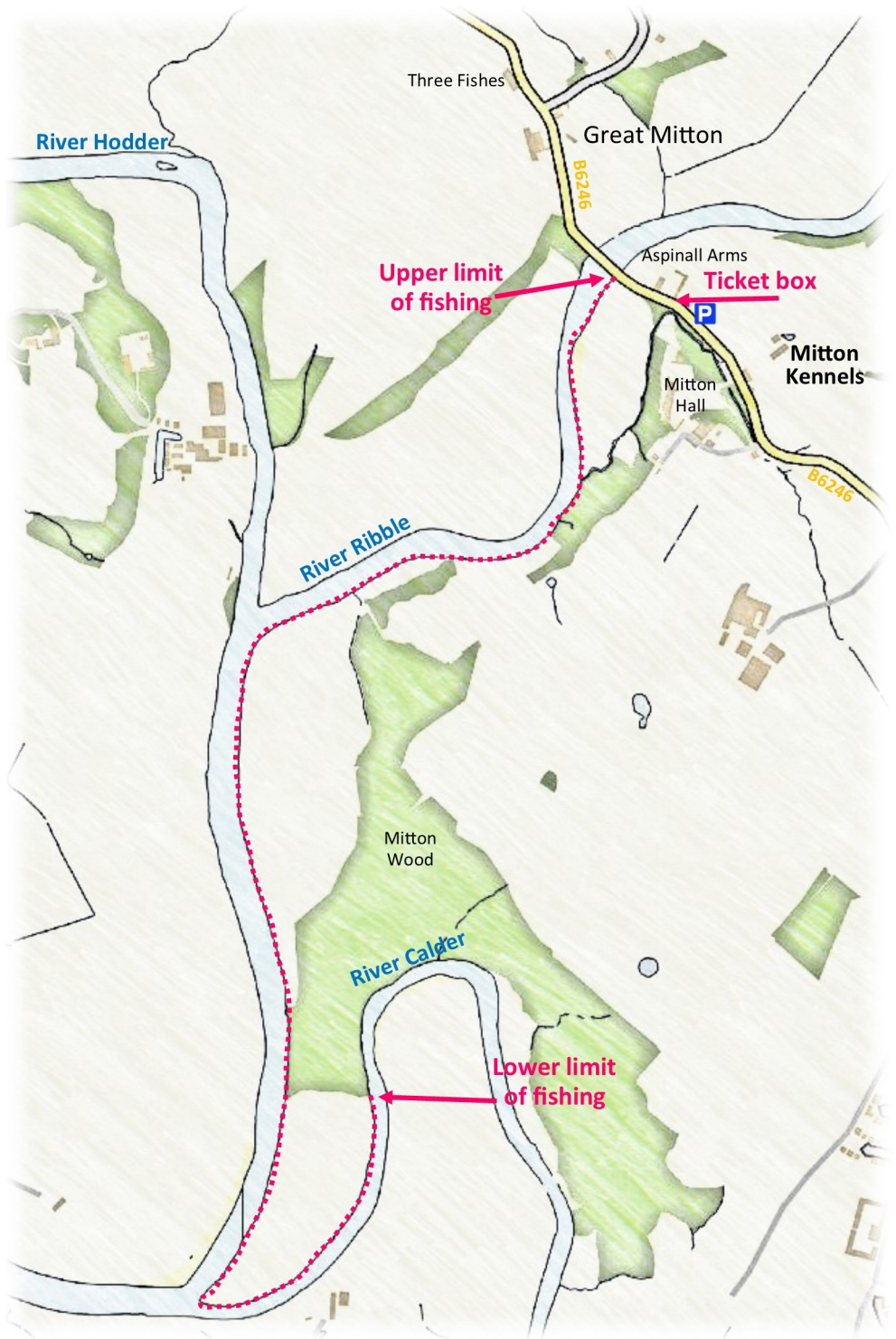
Directions

Leaving Clitheroe via Edisford Bridge, continue for around 5 miles then turn left, signposted Whalley. Pass the Three Fishes on the right hand side then cross the bridge. Parking is in the layby on the left after the Aspinall Arms.
