Situated in the Forest of Bowland Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, this is a long section of the River Loud, comprised of both upland and lowland river types giving a variety of fishing types and challenges. Some tree lined places require accurate casting with short rods, other places are open, but short rods are still advised. There are brown trout and occasional sea trout caught, and every chance of a grayling or even chub.

This Angling Passport beat is kindly provided by the Loud and Hodder Angling Association, whose members will continue to fish this beat.

Restrictions

No fishing the River Hodder. Maggots, ground bait, shrimp and prawn are prohibited. You must use barbless hooks, only one rod per angler to be used at any one time, cast and step is mandatory, no fishing from bridges, do not wade beyond centre line of single bank fishing or cast back towards own bank, 100% catch and release, and catch returns must be submitted in token boxes.

Methods permitted: Fly, spinner or worm

Directions

Parking is along the roadside in pull ins as indicated on the map. Access to fishing is along footpaths or as indicated. Anglers must remain within 15 feet of fishing except where on public footpaths. Please ensure any electric fences around access points are left switched on. The token boxes are attached to posts in locations indicated on the map
