Situated in the Forest of Bowland Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, this is the second longest beat in the passport scheme. The beat is comprised of principally lowland type river with a few tree lined places. The fishability is quite good, however still requires accurate casting with short rods. There are brown trout and every chance of grayling or even chub.

This Angling Passport beat is kindly provided by the Loud and Hodder Angling Association, whose members will continue to fish this beat.

Restrictions

Maggots, ground bait, shrimp and prawn are prohibited. You must use barbless hooks, only one rod per angler to be used at any one time, cast and step is mandatory, no fishing from bridges, do not wade beyond centre line of single bank fishing or cast back towards own bank, 100% catch and release, and catch returns must be submitted in token boxes.

Methods permitted: Fly, spinner or worm

Directions

Parking is tricky and there is one suitable roadside pull in indicated, requiring a fair bit of walking to access fishing. Take care to park safely and do not block farm access. Access to fishing is along footpaths or as indicated. Anglers must remain within 15 feet of fishing except where on public footpaths. Please ensure any electric fences around access points are left switched on. The token boxes are attached to posts in locations indicated on the map.
