Barbless hooks only.

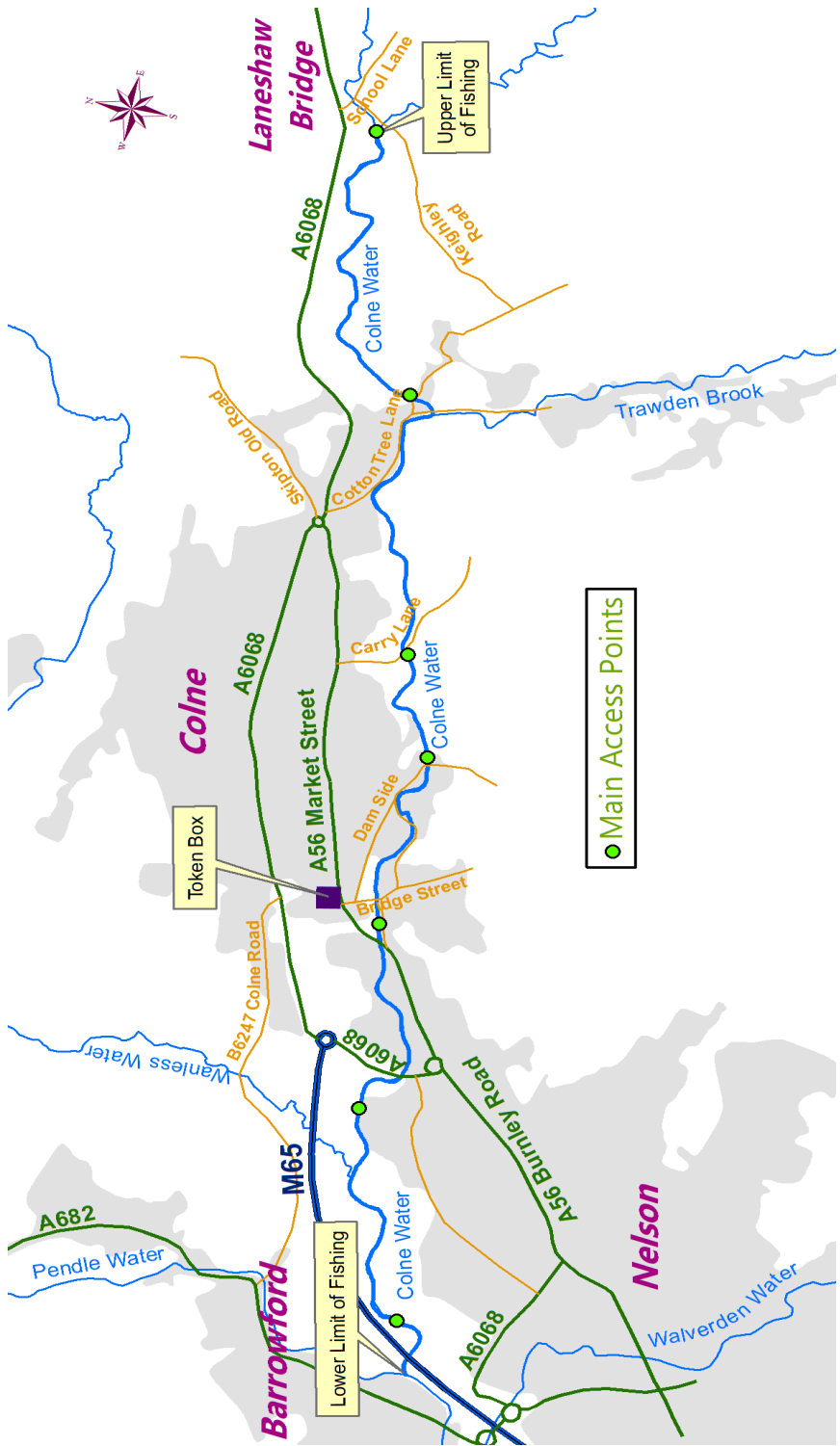
Access

There are multiple access points to the river, in general these are anywhere a public footpath or highway abuts the river. The main access points are: Ball Grove Park, Carry Lane, Waterside Bridge, Knotts Lane, Greenfield Nature Reserve and the playing fields at Barrowford (off Wilton Street).
