Mearley Brook begins on Pendle Hill and flows towards Clitheroe, picking up more and more small becks before entering the town. This beat encompasses the stretch of Mearley Brook after it emerges the other side of Clitheroe and shortly before it joins the main River Ribble. There are fantastic brown trout, chub and other coarse species inhabiting this beat.

Restrictions

Any legal methods permitted, except shrimp bait. 100% catch and release, see restrictions and advice on tackle and information on how to release fish.

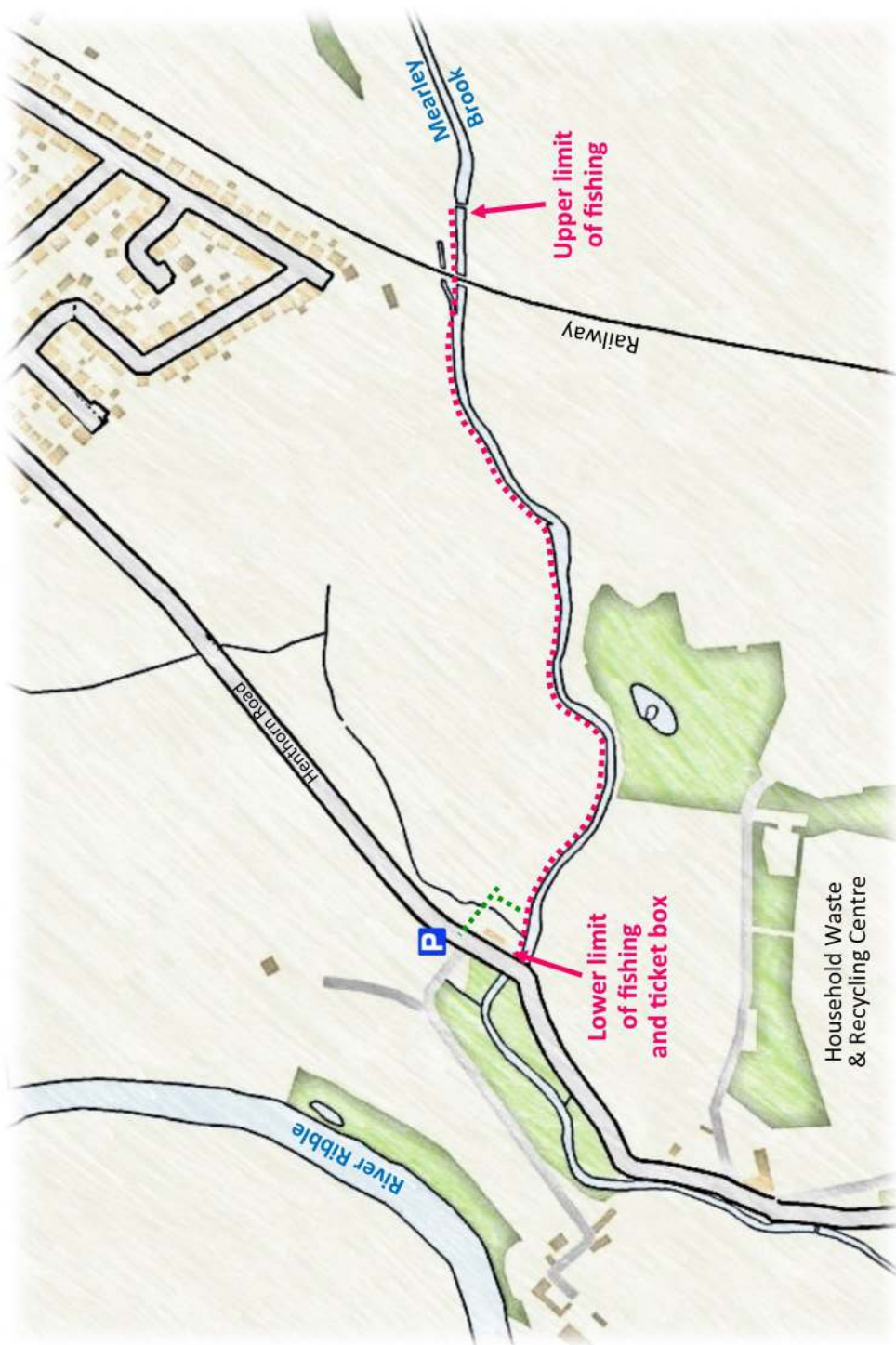
Directions

Henthorn Road is located on the outskirts of Clitheroe on the approach to Edisford. Follow the road down past the new housing development and park up just before you reach the narrow bridge. Access through the gate to the left of the two houses and follow the path before cutting right down to the brook.
