

A copy of the topographic survey of the bed levels down-stream of the weir and the levels of debris that has been washed down over the years. This information is key to determining the extent of de-watering that will be required.

Following the receipt of this query additional topographical data was obtained. A review of this data showed a discrepancy with previously held data. The updated topo data has been confirmed as correct to the clients satisfaction. As a result a review of the design drawings highlighted that the previously issued fish pass type was not appropriate for this location. Subsequently a re-design has occurred and an updated outline design drawing is now issued. This is provided in PDF and CAD format. The new fish pass type is Alaskan A. The NEC contract has also been updated - particularly the price list - to reflect this change. In light of this change a further 1 week extension to the tender submission date is provided. This is reflected in the Invitation to Tender and the Procurement Timetable. Further queries from prospective tenderers will be considered, and if clarifications are to be issued this will be via the procurement webpage, on an ongoing basis, and as such prospective tenderers are encouraged to visit the procurement page regularly.
